In addition, Mayor submitted The Town of Swansea Schedule for Holidays. There was a great deal of discussion from all of council of what days possibly should be inclusive or exclusive. This was to include Veterans Day, Confederate to Juneteenth to the number of days and speaking with the staff.

There were no decisions made at that time and would be revisited at the next General Meeting.

The reading of Lexington County Animal Control Ordinance was delayed as council did not receive the correct copy in their package. To include: Town of Swansea letterhead, Index as chapter 5; for Town of Swansea Ordinance.

A motion by Councilwoman Simmons to table approving the Animal Control Ordinance until council receives a true copy of said ordinance to move forward. It was second by Councilwoman Butler. Roll Call: Council Luongo-Yes, Davis-Yes, Simmons-Yes, Butler-Yes. Measure Passed.

## **POLICE DEPARTMENT**

Chief Williams shared he had seen a number of comments on Face Book. He encouraged Council to take back their District. Packages were being taken off porches. Let others know to remove them as soon as possible.

He is currently going to all businesses to get Key Holders contact information. In addition, to creating a spread sheet to contact and look out for those vulnerable adults during inclement weather hot or cold, whereas vulnerable adults become victims.

Mayor stated, the Senior Center Director could help him with a list on all of the seniors in the area of the Town of Swansea. Mayor also told Chief, the businesses liked what they see and the actions he is doing in escorts to the bank. The Mayor thanked him for what he is doing with the businesses.
