## Council Meeting on April 28

Town Council will conduct its regular monthly meeting on Monday, April 28, starting at 6:00 PM in Council Chambers, 320 W. Third Street. The agenda will be posted at Town Hall and on the town's website and Facebook page closer to the meeting, and the meeting is open to the public. # Council Considering 2% Local Hospitality Tax

A presentation and first reading of a proposed local hospitality tax was on the agenda for Town Council's meeting on March 24, but it was tabled until the next regular meeting on April 28. The proposal calls for customers of any business serving prepared foods to pay an extra 2 percent sales tax at the point of purchase, starting July 1, 2025.



Food service businesses would then be required to report and remit the local hospitality taxes collected to the town on a regular basis, starting in August 2025. Currently, customers buying prepared foods in Swansea pay state sales taxes of 7 percent, which the food service businesses then report/remit to the SC Department of Revenue.

By law, the Town must keep local hospitality tax receipts separate from all other receipts—and use the local hospitality tax funds only for specific expenditures that help draw more visitors to the town. More visitors to Swansea means more business—and potentially more prosperity for the entire community.

"Most neighboring municipalities in Lexington County have implemented local hospitality tax, so when we choose to eat in Gaston or Cayce, we're paying an extra two cents per dollar to help improve those communities," says Town Administrator Chris Keefer. "Given the amount of people who pass through Swansea on the state highways and US 321 and the number of food service businesses we have here in town, our community would benefit significantly by implementing a local hospitality tax."

After first reading of the local hospitality tax ordinance on April 28, the Town staff will be conducting meetings in May with the public and with businesses to provide more information and answer any questions. Watch for announcements by email and on the Town's Facebook page and website.

# Did You Know...

...that residents living inside Swansea town limits are prohibited from burning leaves, brush, limbs, paper, boards, or tires (Town Ordinance Sec. 11.19). The best way to dispose of these items is to take them to the appropriate Lexington County solid waste facility.

Residents of unincorporated areas of Lexington County surrounding Swansea are subject to the county's Outdoor Burning



ordinance, which prohibits the open burning of leaves, tree branches, and yard trimming at private residences within 75 feet of any structure and/or property line.

While the South Carolina Forestry Commission has recently lifted the state-wide burn ban in 41 counties (including Lexington), County residents should check the Forestry Commission's website before starting a fire as weather conditions will vary during the spring. County residents planning to conduct outdoor burning of residential yard debris or prescribed burns must still notify the Forestry Commission before doing so. Notification procedures as well as mandatory precautions for conducting burns may be found on the SCFC website.
